EXHIBITOR RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR CONTRACTED EXHIBIT SPACE

(Please read carefully, initial and return. Save a copy for reference)

 designated exhibit hours. Exhibitor shall be responsible for the conduct of all employees, visitors, agents or
 guests of Exhibitor in or around the leased space.
- 3. Per Larimer County Fire Regulations, due to the nature of the facility's interior fire sprinkler systems, exhibitors may not erect covered tents in the booths.
- 4. MHP reserves the right to restrict the Exhibitor's use of sound and other devices, which may interfere with the best interest of the entire show. The use of sound equipment, such as microphones, televisions, VCRs and DVD players, will be permitted where appropriate to the display, provided the sound is maintained at not more than a conversation level.
- 5. An Exhibitor conducting a FREE DRAWING in the show must, prior to the opening of the show, notify a member of show management about the drawing and the gifts to be awarded and, after the show's closing, notify the show management to whom the prizes are being awarded.
